

Information For Lift Operator Applicants

Description Of Duties

Lift operators work directly with the public. They assist skiers and snowboarders in safely using our lifts by offering instruction and slowing, stopping and starting the lift. They are also responsible for maintaining a smooth snow surface at the loading and unloading areas and for ensuring that all passengers are wearing a valid lift ticket.

Qualifications

Lift operators **must be at least 18 years old.**

Applicants should be alert and in good physical condition as the position requires frequent shoveling and lifting. They must be well groomed; capable of working with the public and presenting a good public relations image. Further, they must be prompt, arriving on time for their scheduled shifts, regardless of adverse travel conditions.

Wages

- The starting rate for lift operators is \$8.50 per hour.
- Pay checks are issued every other Friday.
- Nashoba Valley is a seasonal business and is exempted from paying time and ½ for overtime. Overtime is allowed at the regular rate.

Skiing/Riding Privileges

Lift operators in good standing will be granted free skiing/riding privileges when they are not scheduled to work. They must obtain a daily lift ticket from the lift supervisor.

Scheduling

Lift operators are scheduled on an individual basis. Unless altered by the lift supervisor, an individuals schedule remains the same from week to week. Nashoba Valley is closes at 5:00 pm on Christmas Eve and remains closed on Christmas day and night, otherwise we are open every day of our operating season. Holidays are busy times at Nashoba Valley. On holidays, all lift operators must work their scheduled shifts.

Full time lift operators work 4 days or nights Monday thru Friday and every other Saturday and Sunday:

Full time shift #1: 8:15 AM - 5:30 PM

Full time shift #2: 1:00 PM - 10:30 PM

Part time lift operators are scheduled on an individual basis. They **must be available for at least 1 weekend shift.**
